



Master of Roster: Supreme Court



The 'Chief Justice of India' (CJI) is an individual judge and not the powerful collective of five senior-most judges of the **Supreme Court** called the 'Collegium', the Supreme Court held on Friday.

And it is this exclusive authority of this individual judge, who is the "spokesperson of the court", to allocate cases to fellow judges as the '**Master of Roster**', a Bench of Justices A.K. Sikri and Ashok Bhushan declared in their separate but concurring opinions.



Lok Sabha passes Criminal Law (Amendment) Bill 2018

The Criminal Law (Amendment) Bill 2018 has been passed by the Lok Sabha. This bill takes over the Criminal Law (Amendment) Ordinance declared on 21st April 2018. It sets out the rigorous punishment for the rapists who rape girls less than 12 years and 16 years. For raping a girl under 12 years, the accused will be given a death penalty and in case of girls below 16 years, a minimum penalty of 20 years jail which can be extended up to life imprisonment. The time limit of two months has also been set for the investigation of rape cases



August 2018

76th Anniversary of Quit India Movement

The 76th anniversary of Quit India movement was observed across India on August 8, 2018. On this day in 1942, father of the nation Mahatma Gandhi gave the famous clarion call of 'Do or Die' to all Indians to drive the British away from the country. The movement, also known as the August Kranti Diwas, was launched at the Bombay session of the All-India Congress Committee (AICC), at the height of the Second World War.



September 2018

Aadhaar Act Supreme Court

While upholding the constitutional validity of Aadhaar scheme, the Supreme Court has ruled that Aadhaar Act doesn't violate your right to privacy when you agree to share biometric data. Private entities have been barred from using Aadhaar card for KYC authentication purposes but you will still need Aadhaar for various other purposes including PAN card and ITR filing.



NITI Aayog Yojna



Army starts recruiting women soldiers

Indian army, from Thursday, April 25, 2019 onwards, began their process of recruiting women soldiers or 'jawans'. The army aims to incorporate 20% of the military police cadre from female ranks. Women, till now, were only inducted as officers in the armed forces and were not allowed to fight using arms. Also, just around 1500 women are there in the army, 1600 in IAF, and only about 500 in the Indian Navy, that too in the 65,000 strong cadre of officers. The data for the combined strength is 14 lakh armed forces, of which women are a miniscule percentage.


Asian Games 2018: Shooters Ravi Kumar and Apurvi Chandela win bronze for India

North Korea and South Korea march under the Korean Unification Flag at the opening ceremony and for the first time competed as a unified team in some events. They also won their first medals, one silver and one bronze medal as a unified team. In addition, Philippines and Kuwait won their first ever Asian Para Games gold medals, while Laos and East Timor won their first ever Asian Para Games medals including their first gold medals. There were 16 world, 63 Asian and 246 Asian Para Games records broken during the Games.

G20 Leaders pledge to fight climate change; India to host G20 Summit in 2022

The G20 Summit 2018 concluded on December 1, 2018 in the city of Buenos Aires, Argentina. Nineteen leaders of the world's biggest economies and representatives of the European Union held a meeting together as part of the G20 summit. It was the 13th meeting of Group of Twenty (G20) and the first G20 summit to be hosted in South America. President Mauricio Macri of Argentina assumed the presidency of G20 on November 30, 2017 for one year during an official ceremony in Kirchner Cultural Centre in Buenos Aires, Argentina. The leaders of the Group agreed to fix the world trading system, however, only 19 agreed to support the Paris accord on fighting climate change with the United States holding onto its withdrawal. In a joint declaration, the leaders of G20 nations, except for US President Donald Trump, reaffirmed their commitment to fight climate change by upholding the Paris Agreement.
