It is one of the largest multi- campuses and multi-faculty deemed to be University in the country. RESEARCH

The University is having three self-financing research institutes as its constituent units viz. (i) Interactive Research School for Health Affairs (IRSHA), (ii) Yashwantrao Chavan Institute of Social Sciences Studies & Research, (YCISR) Pune and (iii) Research and Development Centre in Pharmaceutical Sciences & Applied Chemistry, Pune. The research work carried out particularly in IRSHA is globally accepted. The university receives funding to the tune of 1279.68 lakhs from various funding agencies for research projects at national and international levels by teachers and students. During the last two years, the faculty members together have published 2925 research papers in prestigious peer reviewed journals, out of which 1848 are in international journals and 1077 are in national level journals.

The university attracts students not only from different parts of India but also from abroad.
